- Have you Enrolled in the program?

water for lead.

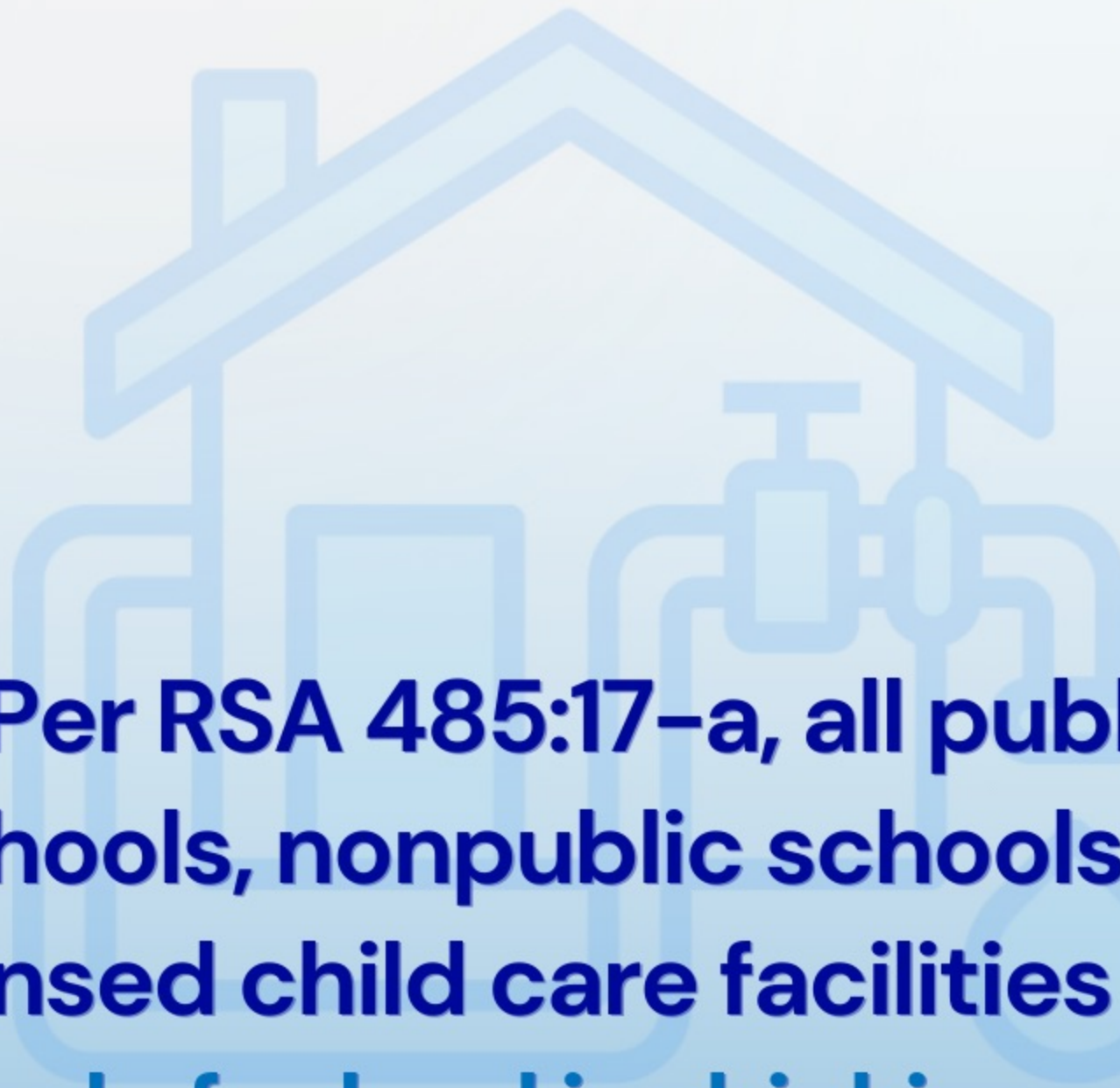

Reducing lead exposure at schools
and child care programs



Per RSA 485:17-a, all public schools, nonpublic schools and licensed child care facilities must sample for lead in drinking water.



3

**rounds of sampling must be
completed at each facility.
Rounds must be spaced 6
months apart.**

**Further action must be
taken at outlets where lead
results are at or above:
5 parts per billion
(ppb)**



Get the Lead Out of Drinking Water

**Grant funding is available to

for up to
100%
of total remediation costs**
