Per RSA 485:17-a, all public schools, nonpublic schools and licensed child care facilities must sample for lead in drinking water.



rounds of sampling must be completed at each facility. Rounds must be spaced 6 months apart.



Further action must be taken at outlets where lead results are at or above:

5 parts per billion (ppb)



Grant funding is available to reimburse eligible facilities for up to

100%
of total remediation costs
