
# Hello and Welcome!

### Registering in NHCIS

For a smooth experience, we recommend using Google Chrome or Firefox when logging in to your NHCIS account.

- 1. Login to your **NHCIS account**
- 2. Click on the Training Tile
- 3. Click on, "Take a New Training", this will take you to the "Event Calendar Page"
- 4. You can view trainings in three (3) formats: by list, week, or month a. Use "Week View" or "Month View" to register (registration CANNOT be completed in "List View")
- 5. Click the title of the training and then the blue "Register" button
  - a. If the training is offered multiple times, please click on "Sessions" to register for your intended date


