TYPES OF Professional Development Opportunities



Early Childhood Virtual Learning Communities

Formerly known as Collaboratives, our Virtual Learning Communities (VLCs) are monthly trainings from September to June, centered on specific topics. They foster conversations, offer professional development, and provide updates and State info for professionals, administrators, providers and more.



 Early Childhood Cohorts bring programs together to work on specific State initiatives.
Participants collaborate, obtain resources, and receive training, technical assistance, and coaching in a supportive setting.



Special Events

Special events are half-day training sessions with one or more presenters, focused on specific topics.



Progressive Training & TA Program

The Progressive Training and Technical Assistance (TA) Program offers individualized coaching and assistance to child care programs directly. Programs commit to work with CCAoNH long-term and at their own pace to improve practices related to a State Initiative.



Trainings

Trainings are 1-3 hour professional development sessions held on afternoons, nights and weekends. They cover relevant early childhood topics.



Conferences

Conferences are full-day events with keynote speakers and various trainings on topics aligned with personal professional development needs.

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
