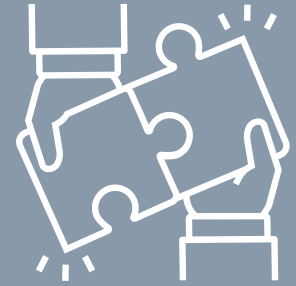


Early Childhood Virtual Learning Communities
